

District 67 — Sunnyside (East)

Organized on November 4, 1879. Entire district was in Camp Phillips area and was disorganized on August 2, 1942. Building originally located in the southeast corner of Section 2 of Summit Township. New school was later built one-half mile south in Section 11. Remodeled and a basement built in 1927 at a cost of \$1,432.64. Property sold to U.S. Government and the building was eventually destroyed.

Negro School Board Of the Nine Families Living In The District, Six are Colored.

District No. 67 is remembered as the district, which so prominently before the public last winter in the dispute over the hiring of a teacher. A colored teacher was hired as usual, but the county superintendent refused to endorse her certificate and placed a white teacher in the school. The school board and colored teacher finally won in the state supreme court and have had charge of the school



DANISH AND SWEDISH IMMIGRANTS COMING TO

SALINE COUNTY, KANSAS

MAY 1868 - JULY 1903


As Reflected by Records of the Copenhagen Police Department

On May 1, 1868, in the wake of numerous scandals involving trusting emigrants who had been cheated by Danish Emigration agents, the Danish parliament passed a law calling for the stricter regulation of these agents. In accordance with this law, the Copenhagen Chief of Police had to approve and monitor the work of all the emigration agents in Denmark and to authorize all tickets to overseas destinations. This was to be done regardless of whether the migrant sailed directly from Copenhagen to the United States of indirectly, via another European harbor. 394,000 Danes emigrated during the years 1869 - 1908.
